Division of Disability Services (DDS) serves as the single point of entry for people seeking disability-related information in New Jersey.

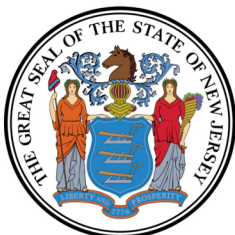

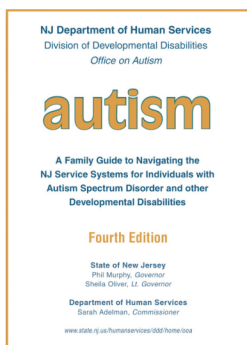
